## Decorative glasses: aesthetic solutions for interiors

As the perfect symbiosis of colour and glass, decorative glasses provide the most varying possibilities for optical design of modern interiors. Regardless of whether it involves opaque float glasses of the Lacobel series provided with high-quality coating layers or decorative glass products from the Matelac series with lacquered and matted surfaces – lacquered glass surfaces set colour accents, play with light and shade and thereby repeatedly sets rooms in the scene again.

The contrast of light and dark, bright and matt coloured glass surfaces gives the room verve and perspective. Tubs and wall surfaces clad in bright pastel blue with Lacobel harmonise perfectly with the Matelac wall element retained in brown.

Lacquered glass in harmony with current trends: high-gloss Lacobel and silk-matt Matelac. The existing colour palette has been expanded by a few new shades as a motivation for designers and architects (compare page 6/7).

## Structures accentuated by colourful accents

Contemporary design is often characterised by a down-to-earth approach and tradition. Natural colours and materials (here light colours and grey tones in a stone and slate look) form the perfect setting for the washbasin console made of lacquered glass in warm red and thus create a perfect atmosphere.

Lacquered glass provides a kaleidoscopic variety of colours and reflections. The palette can be expanded even more with a combination of Lacobel and Matelac. The light captured in matt Matelac colours is reflected in the sparkling Lacobel tones. Some Matelac and Lacobel colours are complementary to „tone on tone” creations: brown, anthracite, yellow and blue. Try it out.

## Lacobel & Matelac

Lacobel is coated in colour on the back side of the glass. This not only protects the colour coating but also retains the permanent luminance and brilliance of the colour. Lacobel is exclusively suitable for interior applications such as wall claddings, interior decorations or also as a writing tablet.

Matelac is lacquered on one side and acid-etched on the other. The highly developed etching technique gives the glass the silk-matt look. The light-tight look is created through a high-quality colour application on the back side of the glass. Interior designers appreciate Matelac because of its various possible uses for wall claddings, doors, tables, shelves and cabinets.

Advantages and applications:

- Lacobel and Matelac are suitable for diverse interior applications such as wall claddings, room dividers, furniture or doors. They provide a clean and contemporary appearance with easy maintenance and high insensitivity to stains.
- All colours available for Lacobel and Matelac are suitable for moist rooms.
- A SAFE film on the lacquered side of the glass provides even more protection against injuries and damages in the event of a breakage of glass.
- The manufacturing technique utilised guarantees a consistent and flawless lacquer application adhering to the glass.
- Exclusively environmentally friendly lacquers are utilised for Lacobel and Matelac. In accordance with the stringent JIS test standard (JIS A 1460:2000), no formaldehydes whatsoever were detected.

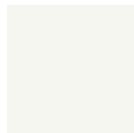

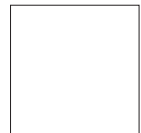

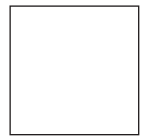
